Publications:

My main area of interest is islands and small states studies, in particular economic aspects, and I have authored many publications on this subject. I am known internationally for my seminal work on the "Vulnerability Index" (see for example *World Development*, Sept 1995) which led to a world-wide interest and to many quantitative studies on Economic and Environmental Vulnerability. I also authored journal articles and books, and edited book on various economic aspects including economic competitiveness.

I am editor of *Bank of Valletta Review* published by the Bank of Valletta and one of the editors of *Insula International Journal of Island Affairs*, published in collaboration with UNESCO. I also serves on the editorial boards of a number of other journals. For a time I was general editor of the *Islands Series* published by Cassell, London.

I authored or co-authored published documents relating to a Sustainable Developing Strategy for Malta and a Competitiveness Strategy for Malta.

I am also the correspondent for *Encyclopaedia Britannica* and for *the Europa World Yearbook* for entries relating to Malta.

Professional Experience:

I acted as consultant to several international organisations including the UN Department of Policy Coordination, UNCTAD, UNEP, UNDP, CARICOM, the Commonwealth Secretariat and SOPAC. I represented the Maltese government in many United Nations meetings.

I am one of the lead authors for the chapter on Small Island States of the Fourth Assessment Report by the Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change (IPCC) entitled *Impacts, Vulnerability and Adaptation*. I also acted as lead author for the Third Assessment Report.

Currently I am member of the National Commission for Sustainable Development (Malta) and of the Malta Commission for Fair Trading. For a time I was member of the Malta-EU Steering and Action Committee.
